Welcome to the start of the new academic year. It has been fantastic to welcome all our students back to the Academy today and we are looking forward to a highly productive, enjoyable and rewarding year ahead.

The building work to remodel the site following the demolition of the old building is nearly complete and we are hopeful that this will be finished very shortly and we can finally utilise all of the new facilities.

We are now able to use the first floor of B Block and we have housed our maths team in this building, along with all the year 7 form bases. As a result of having two separate buildings we have invested in key fob security for student entrances. This will ensure that we can control who enters the Academy buildings. In order for students to be able to move between blocks all students will have lanyards with electronic key cards which allow them to open the appropriate student doors during the Academy day. These lanyards now form part of the school uniform and as such must be worn at all times on the Academy site. If a student loses their lanyard then a replacement will need to be purchased from the Academy.

Today saw the completion of the 2 on-site tests for Covid 19. Having now tested those students with permission, we move to the familiar regime of home testing. Kits for students to complete this will be issued this week and we ask that all students complete a test on a Wednesday and Sunday evening. Changes to the Government guidance means that should a student test positive (and this was confirmed by a PCR test), we no longer need to ask other students to isolate. Instead testing will be used to determine if any other students need to remain at home.

Information Evenings

We will be running information evenings for parents of each year group in the coming weeks. These evenings are designed to give parents updated information about Academy systems, support and further detail about the curriculum for each year group. We very much hope you will be able to attend, see our new building and strengthen the partnership between the Academy and home.

The building and facilities will be open to anyone in the community to view from 6pm to 7pm on this date and we look forward to welcoming ex-students from our community to this event.

Expectations

With the summer holidays now over we wanted to remind parents of a few key expectations:

Piercings, other than single studs in the ear, are not permitted within the Academy. If a student has any other piercings, for example a nose stud, this must either be removed or replaced with a plastic retainer.

Punctuality is of huge importance, and with the Academy buildings now being set back further from the road it is important that students arrive in good time to get to their morning registration by 8.30am. We recommend that all students are on site by 8.25am giving them sufficient time to arrive to their form room in a punctual fashion.

All students are expected to arrive on the academy site with the correct equipment for the day's learning. A pen, pencil, ruler, rubber and a scientific calculator are the essentials we ask students to carry with them. Scientific calculators can be purchased from the Academy using parentmail (£4.85) and collected from your child's maths teacher.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club runs each morning from 8.00am and is open to all year groups. Students can attend and choose from a wide range of breakfast treats including; crumpets, cereal and toast. Student wishing to partake of this should come to the canteen at 8.00am.
