

The near future tense

You use the near future tense to say what you are going to do. To form the near future tense, use the present tense of *ir* (to go) + *a*, followed by the infinitive. See all the parts of *ir* on page 12.

Voy a comer palomitas. I am going to eat popcorn.

Vamos a jugar al tenis. We are going to play tennis.

Do you remember how to form the near future tense?
Use the present tense of the verb *ir* followed by a plus the infinitive.

Voy a ver una comedia. I am going to see a comedy.

Vas a comer palomitas. You are going to eat popcorn.

Va a ser guay. It is going to be cool.

Vamos a escuchar... We are going to listen to...

Vais a venir. You (pl) are going to come.

Van a ir al cine. They are going to go to the cinema.
