

# Post-16 Evening, Wednesday 27th September – Mrs Fosker

We are holding a Post-16 Information Evening on Wednesday 27th September, 4:30pm-6:30pm and all Year 10 and 11 students and parents are welcome. During this event your child will have the opportunity to speak to an array of post-16 providers, employers and universities. The purpose of the evening is to encourage students to start to think about their next steps after they leave Ormiston Endeavour Academy. The evening will also help your child develop an insight into the knowledge and skills required when moving on from school into post-16 provision. All students are now expected to stay in some form of education or training until the age of 18; this event will provide them with an appreciation of the options available to them when they finish their GCSEs.

The event is open to both year 10 and 11 students, as we feel it is important that your child starts to consider and engage with their career aspirations as early as possible.
