Expansion consultation proposal

Stakeholder public questionnaire

The proposal to expand the number of students on roll at Ormiston Endeavour Academy.

As Ipswich continues to grow, the new housing development Ipswich Garden Suburb, will see an additional 3500 homes built when fully completed. With this in mind we are looking to expand from having a maximum pupil admission number of 900 students, to a new maximum admission number of 1200 students.

To support this growth the local authority are working with the Academy to provide additional new facilities. This will be in the form of a new building, providing the capacity for such an increase in student numbers. The project for the new building is currently set to be completed for September 2027 in good time for the planned growth.

It is incredibly important to us that we hear the views of everyone in our community in relation to the plans for this expansion because we want to ensure that any change has our children's best interests at the heart.

The formal consultation period for this will run from Monday 28th April 2025 until midday on Friday 16th May 2025.
