Welcome back

Further to the message sent earlier this week, we would like to let you know that students have made a fabulous start. Thank you to all parents for your ongoing support.

Period 5

Students in Years 7 – 10 will begin a new study programme next week with their form tutor. Each week, students have a 'period 5' (their penultimate lesson of the day, a development of our tutorial programme) which takes place alongside their lunchbreak. This programme addresses four key areas of focus at Endeavour:

- Endeavour Reader; students share a class reading book, led by their form tutor. As they read, students have the opportunity to discuss and reflect on the book.
- Endeavour Learner; students develop their understanding of learning and independent study skills.
- Endeavour Citizen; complementing existing citizenship learning across PSHEe and other subjects at the
 academy, students undertake a range of discussion based activities, enabling them to reflect on issues
 relating to local, British and global citizenship. Their first unit develops their understanding of rights and
 responsibilities.
- Endeavour Achiever; students are given time and guidance to reflect on their progress, attendance and key learning each week. This enables students to complete some personal goal setting, with the support of their form tutor.

On one day each week, each year group has a longer lunch, creating an opportunity for students to enjoy and benefit from additional social time.

Online assessments

At various points throughout the year, students will undertake a small number of online assessments. These are typically to assess reading, as well as some additional assessments we use to reflect on knowledge and understanding in some subjects, as well as students' views of school. These assessments help us to identify additional activity and provision that can be put in place to support individual students, as well as any suitable adjustments to the wider curriculum. Our first assessments, a reading test, will take place over the coming weeks for all students in Years 7-10.
