Suffolk One Year 10 Taster Day - Thursday 9th July

As part of the "Careers Education, Information, Advice & Guidance" offer that we give to all students in preparation for them moving onto post 16 education and employment, a visit has been arranged to Suffolk One Thursday 9th July. Students should have already made their subject choices, and a timetable will be emailed to students before the day. The idea is to give students as full an experience of a day at Suffolk One as possible.

The visit will take place during normal school hours and students will be taken to and from Suffolk One by coach. Staff from Ormiston Endeavour Academy will accompany the students, though staff from Suffolk One will run the taster day once we arrive.

Students are expected to wear the academy uniform, as normal on this day but if they have chosen sport, they are welcome to bring trainers and their PE Kit. Students can bring their own lunch or purchase something from the canteen. If your child is free school meals, a lunch will be provided for them, please confirm this on Arbor and give your consent for your student to attend the trip.

Any students who did not make their subject choices, will be in school as normal, as unfortunately timetables have been put together and the day planned, so students are unable to just turn up.

Year 10 Work Experience - Monday 29th June - Friday 3rd July 2026

Next week, students, parents and employers should have all received all the information required for work experience. Please read all the information carefully as it has all the information students need to know regarding their placement, what time to start and finish, what to wear, whether they need a pack lunch, where to go and who to report to on their first day.

If students are not familiar with their placement and going somewhere new, it might be a good idea to familiarise yourself with where you are going a few days before you are due to start, make contact with the person you are reporting to and introduce yourself. It's important to make a good first impression and not to be late on your first day.

Work experience is a great opportunity to learn, grow, and explore future career paths. Make the most of it by being curious, asking questions, and getting involved in as many activities as possible. Students will have the chance to develop new skills, gain confidence, and meet people who can inspire and support you.
